

**REPORT TO THE

A budget meeting of the Board of Carbon County Commissioners (BOCC) commenced Wednesday, June 25, 2014 at the County Courthouse in Rawlins, Wyoming. Attending the meeting were; Chairman Leo Chapman; Vice Chairman John Espy; Commissioners Lindy Glode, Sue Jones and John Johnson; County Clerk Gwynn Bartlett; and County Treasurer Cindy Baldwin.

Chairman Chapman called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

**BUDGET AMENDMENT FY 2014**

Chairman Chapman opened a public hearing at 9:00 a.m. to hear comments on amending the county's fiscal year 2014 budget.

Clerk Bartlett reported that notice of this public hearing was advertised in the Daily Times June 21. She stated that the administration budget will be amended with funds transferred from a reserve fund in the amount of \$297,000.00. Chairman Chapman called for comments and hearing no comments, closed the public hearing at 9:03 a.m.

Commissioner Jones moved to adopt Resolution No. 2014-14, FY 2014 Budget Amendment Number Three adding \$297,000.00 to the Administration budget. Commissioner Espy seconded and the motion carried unanimously.
