

**REPORT TO THE
MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF
CARBON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
BUDGET MEETING
Tuesday, June 23, 2015
County Courthouse, Rawlins, Wyoming**

A budget meeting of the Board of Carbon County Commissioners (BOCC) commenced Tuesday, June 23, 2015 at the County Courthouse in Rawlins, Wyoming. Attending the meeting were; Chairman John Espy; Vice Chairman John Johnson; Commissioners Lindy Glode, and Sue Jones; County Clerk Gwynn Bartlett; and County Treasurer Cindy Baldwin. Commissioner Leo Chapman was absent.

Chairman Espy called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

BUDGET AMENDMENT FY 2015

Chairman Espy opened a public hearing at 9:00 a.m. to hear comments on amending the county’s fiscal year 2015 budget.

Clerk Bartlett reported that notice of this public hearing was advertised in the Daily Times June 19. She stated that the following budgets will be amended with funds transferred from a reserve fund. Increase to Boards of \$1,049.91 and increase Treasurer \$2,968.85, reducing reserves \$4,018.76. Chairman Espy called for comments and hearing no comments, closed the public hearing at 9:04 a.m.

Commissioner Johnson moved to adopt Resolution No. 2014-14, FY 2014 Budget Amendment Number Two. Commissioner Glode seconded and the motion carried unanimously.
