

**MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF
CARBON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
BUDGET WORKSHOP
Wednesday, May 27 & 28, 2009
County Courthouse, Rawlins, Wyoming**

The regular meeting of the Board of Carbon County Commissioners (BOCC) commenced Wednesday, May 27, 2008 at the County Courthouse in Rawlins, Wyoming. Attending the meeting were Chairman Terry Weickum, Commissioners Jerry Paxton and Charles Young; County Clerk Gwynn Bartlett; and County Treasurer Cindy Baldwin.

Chairman Terry Weickum called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

BUDGET PRESENTATIONS

Budget presentations were presented by the following: Economic Development Corporation, \$35,000; Albany County Public Library Foundation, \$5,000; Encampment Preschool, \$5,000; Big Brothers / Big Sisters, \$25,000; Medicine Bow Health Center, \$103,900; and Chicano Studies, \$5,000.

Chairman Weickum called a recess at 10:33 a.m. and reconvened at 10:39 a.m.

He stated bids opened were as follows: Oftedal Construction bid \$2,262,320.39; Reiman Corp. bid \$2,137,659.07; High Country Construction, Inc. bid \$2,205,249.00; Scherer Construction LLC bid \$1,786,532.45; and A&D Oilfield Dozers bid \$1,862,403.96.
