FINANCIAL REPORT

The Board approved monthly financial reports from the Carbon County Road & Bridge Department and the Carbon County Planning & Development Department.

GRAY PRIVATE ROAD

Kermit Brown, legal counsel for John & Martha Gray, notified the Board that the Grays intend to file a petition for private road.

JOHNSON CONTROLS

A motion was made by Fleming, seconded by Graalman and unanimously carried to renew with the same terms as previously contracted to enter into an agreement with Johnson Controls for maintenance of the heating and cooling systems in Carbon County Government owned buildings.

CARBON BUILDING

Carbon Building Manager, Patricia Schuler presented lease contracts for office space within the Carbon Building for the Commissioners consideration.

A motion was made by Fleming, seconded by Graalman, and unanimously carried to renew lease agreements with the State of Wyoming, Department of Employment, Vocational Rehabilitation for office space in the Carbon Building.

FORT STEELE HISTORICAL SITE

Dan Brownell and Linda Smith appeared before the Board of Commissioners to request county sponsorship of their \$80,000 TEAL grant application. The grant would partially fund a \$100,000 project to restore the stone corral structure, stabilize foundations, conduct an archeological investigation, upgrade pathways, and install a kiosk at the Fort Steele Historical Site. Smith would administer the grant with finances to be passed through the Carbon County general fund revenue and expenditure accounts. The remaining \$20,000 needed to complete the project would come from the Fort Fred Steele Association.

A motion was made by Graalman, seconded by Fleming and unanimously carried to adopt the following resolution:

RESOLUTION 1998-9

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, CARBON COUNTY, WYOMING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, STATE OF WYOMING, FOR TEAL FUNDS FOR ENHANCEMENTS AT FT. FRED STEELE HISTORIC SITE

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners have reviewed the input from members of the Ft. Fred Steele Historical Development Association for enhancements at Ft. Steele Historical Site, and

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners find that such project is to the benefit of citizens of Carbon County, Wyoming, and

Whereas, the Wyoming Department of Transportation has funds available for this type of project, through the Transportation Enhancement Activities – Local program, in an amount not to exceed \$250,000, subject to a local match of 20%; and

Whereas, this resolution will authorize an application for funding for such enhancements at Ft. Steele Historic Site for TEAL funds, through

the sponsorship of the Carbon County Commissioners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Ft. Fred Steele Historical Development Association be authorized to make application to the Wyoming Department of Transportation for \$80,000, and provide a match of \$20,000 of \$15,000 in cash and \$5,000 in-kind from the State of Wyoming, for enhancements at Ft. Fred Steele Historic Site.

COURTHOUSE

County Court Judge, Margie Meacham accompanied by County Court employees Barbara Casados and Vangie Lucero requested upgrade of the appurtenances in the space occupied by County Court, an agency of the State of Wyoming, and provided by Carbon County Government in accordance with Wyoming State Statute 5-5-127. The improvements estimated at a cost of \$15,000 are: replacement of the judicial bench, coordination of seating fabrics, replacement of council tables, and computer desks for office areas.

Following a tour of the County Court occupied area of the Courthouse, the Commissioners took the request under advisement for consideration in the fiscal year 1998-99 budget.

PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT

County Planner, Johnathan Schnal and County Planning Commissioner, Henry Hewitt appeared before the Board to report on activities of the Carbon County Planning & Development department and Planning Commission.

Request to rezone property located east of Riverside from Ranch-Agriculture-Mining (RAM) to Residential (RD).

A motion was made by Graalman, seconded by Fleming, and unanimously carried to approve Case File 98-05.

Case File 98-07, William D. and Judy M. Richardson.

Request to rezone property located west of Rawlins from Ranch-Agriculture-Mining (RAM) to Residential (RD).

A motion was made by Fleming, seconded by Graalman, and unanimously carried to approve Case File 98-07.

CARBON COUNTY IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS JOINT POWERS BOARD

A motion was made by Graalman, seconded by Zeiger, and unanimously carried to appoint Linda Fleming as County Representative on the Carbon County Improvement Projects Joint Powers Board.

A motion was made by Fleming, seconded by Zeiger, and unanimously carried to appoint Gary Graalman At-Large Representative on the Carbon County Improvement Projects Joint Powers Board.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

A motion was made by Fleming, seconded by Graalman, and unanimously carried to enter into an agreement with the Federal Emergency Management Agency through the Wyoming Emergency Management Agency for financial management of Carbon County Emergency Management Agency's grant-supported activities.

RULES HEARING

A motion was made by Fleming, seconded by Graalman, and unanimously carried to adopt the following:

RESOLUTION 1998-10

“A RESOLUTION PROVIDING NOTICE OF A PUBLIC HEARING ON INTENT TO ADOPT RULES OF PRACTICE GOVERNING HEARINGS AND CONTESTED CASES BEFORE THE CARBON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS”

BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of Carbon County, Wyoming:

- (a) The Carbon County Commissioners shall hold a public hearing on July 21, 1998, at 10:30 a.m., to consider public comment on proposed Rules of Practice Governing Hearings and Contested Cases Before the Carbon County Board of County Commissioners previously adopted as Emergency rules on April 7, 1998; and
- (b) The Carbon County Clerk shall publish a notice of intent to adopt as attached hereto and specifically incorporated herein by reference one time in the Rawlins Daily Times not less than 45 days prior to the date of the public hearing.
