This agreement is made and entered into to be effective as of the 17th day of June, 2010, by and between Carbon County School District No. 1, hereinafter referred to as "CCSD No. 1", Carbon County School District No. 2, hereinafter referred to as "CCSD No. 2", the City of Rawlins, Wyoming, a Municipal Corporation of the State of Wyoming, hereinafter referred to as "City of Rawlins", the Town of Hanna, Wyoming, a Municipal Corporation of the State of Wyoming, hereinafter referred to as "Town of Hanna", the town of Medicine Bow, Wyoming, a Municipal Corporation of the State of Wyoming, hereinafter referred to as "Town of Medicine Bow" the Town of Baggs, Wyoming, a Municipal Corporation of the State of Wyoming, hereinafter referred to as "Town of Baggs", the Town of Saratoga, Wyoming, a Municipal Corporation of the State of Wyoming, hereinafter referred to as "Town of Saratoga", the Town of Encampment, Wyoming, a Municipal Corporation of the State of Wyoming, hereinafter referred to as "Town of Encampment", the Town of Elk Mountain, Wyoming, a Municipal Corporation of the State of Wyoming referred to as "Town of Elk Mountain", the Town of Sinclair, Wyoming, a Municipal Corporation of the State of Wyoming referred to as "Town of Sinclair", and Carbon County, Wyoming, a duly organized county of the State of Wyoming, hereinafter referred to as "Carbon County".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Wyoming Statute §16-1-105 Joint Agreements allows for two (2) or more agencies to enter into agreements with each other for joint or cooperative action; and

WHEREAS, this Joint Powers Agreement is created pursuant to Wyoming Statute §16-1-105, and it is specifically recognized that this agreement does not create a separate legal entity; and

WHEREAS, Wyoming Statute §14-9-101, *et seq.* allows for the creation of a Community Juvenile Service Board, hereinafter referred to as a "CJSB" in Carbon County; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the CJSB is (i) to establish, maintain and promote the development of juvenile services that are aimed at early identification and diversion of children

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at risk of entry into the juvenile court system and preventing juvenile delinquency; and (ii) to allow decisions regarding juvenile services to be made at a local level; and

WHEREAS, the CJSB will review existing juvenile services, develop a community-wide juvenile services strategic plan and ensure that the system of juvenile services employs certain specific practices; and

WHEREAS, the CJSB is eligible for grant funding in the amount of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) or more from the Wyoming Department of Family Services, the Wyoming Department of Health and the Wyoming Department of Education for 2010; and

WHEREAS, stakeholders from the Carbon County Attorney's Office, the Rawlins Police Department, the Carbon County Sheriff's Office, the Department of Family Services, CCSD No. 1, CCSD No. 2, the Wyoming Public Defender's Office, the Board of County Commissioners, Carbon County Counseling Center, Carbon County Public Health and a professional appointed by the Board of County Commissioners who has particular knowledge or expertise in children or young adult services in accordance with Wyoming Statute § 14-9-105(a)(ix) agree that the formation of a CJSB will provide benefit to at-risk juveniles in Carbon County; and

WHEREAS, CCSD No. 1, CCSD No. 2, the City of Rawlins, the Town of Hanna, the Town of Medicine Bow, the Town of Baggs, the Town of Saratoga, the Town of Encampment, the Town of Sinclair, the Town of Elk Mountain and Carbon County (hereinafter referred to as the "Parties") have determined that there is a need within Carbon County to establish a Community Juvenile Services Board; and

WHEREAS, it is the consensus of the parties that funding made available through the aforementioned grant shall be targeted toward the following: enhancing rehabilitative and restorative probation services (including a county diversion program) for at-risk juveniles to prevent removal from the home, enhancing transition services for juveniles returning to the community from residential treatment or other out-of-home placements, risk assessment and development of a Carbon County Crisis Center, with the ultimate goal of reducing delinquency, recidivism and the number of juveniles placed in juvenile detention centers; and

WHEREAS, Wyoming Statute §14-9-105, in conjunction with Community Juvenile Service Board General Provisions §4(c), requires that a Joint Powers Agreement must be in place prior to the CJSB receiving grant funds from the State; and

WHEREAS, no funding is required from the Parties for the creation of the CJSB.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved by CCSD No. 1, CCSD No. 2, the City of Rawlins, the Town of Hanna, the Town of Medicine Bow, the Town of Baggs, the Town of Saratoga, the Town of Encampment, the Town of Sinclair, the Town of Elk Mountain and Carbon County, in past meetings duly assembled, and in consideration of the foregoing and of

the cooperation to be had between the parties and the performance of the promises contained herein, and the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. **Purpose.** The purpose of this agreement is to allow for and support the creation of the Carbon County Community Juvenile Services Board (CJSB) and any and all powers and duties indentified in Wyoming Statute § 14-9-106. The CJSB will work to establish, maintain and promote the development of juvenile services that are aimed at early identification and diversion of children at risk of entry into the juvenile court system and preventing juvenile delinquency. The CJSB shall be an advisory board to the parties pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 16-1-105 (c).

2. **Duration.** This agreement shall commence on the date of approval by the Wyoming Attorney General, following the adoption and approval of this agreement by the parties hereto, and shall terminate five (5) years from said date of adoption and approval, unless sooner terminated or extended as hereinafter provided.

3. **Name.** This agreement creates the Carbon County Community Juvenile Services Board, which is a cooperative action between CCSD No. 1, CCSD No. 2, the City of Rawlins, the Town of Hanna, the Town of Medicine Bow, the Town of Baggs, the Town of Saratoga, the Town of Encampment, the Town of Sinclair, the Town of Elk Mountain and Carbon County.

4. **CJSB Organization and Composition.** The CJSB shall not be considered a separate legal entity. Rather, the CJSB shall act as an administrative board to aid and assist the Parties in the administration of the requirements of Wyoming Statute §14-9-101 *et. seq.*

(a) The CJSB Board shall be appointed by the following

1. Carbon County Commissioners shall appoint a representative from the following offices: a) the Carbon County Attorney's Office; b) the Carbon County Sheriff's Office; c) the Department of Family Services; d) Carbon County Public Health; e) Wyoming Public Defender's Office; f) two mental health professional; g) a professional who has particular knowledge or expertise in children or young adult services in accordance with Wyoming Statute §14-9-105(a)(ix).
2. CCSD No. 1 shall appoint a representative.
3. CCSD No. 2 shall appoint a representative.
4. The City of Rawlins shall appoint a representative from the Rawlins Police Department.
5. The Town of Saratoga shall appoint a representative from the Saratoga Police Department.
6. The Town of Baggs shall appoint a representative from the Baggs Police Department.

7. The Town of Hanna shall appoint a representative from the Hanna Marshal's Office.
8. The Town of Sinclair shall appoint a representative from the Sinclair Police Department.
9. The Town of Encampment shall appoint a representative.
10. The Town of Elk Mountain shall appoint a representative.
11. Each of these seventeen (17) members shall be voting members and decisions shall be made by majority rule of these seventeen (17) members. These seventeen members (17) members shall be selected in a manner determined by each party no later than thirty (30) days after the Attorney General of the State of Wyoming approves this agreement.
12. The seventeen (17) CJSB members appointed by the Parties, as set forth in paragraph 4.a, shall each serve for a three (3) year term. The initial term of six of the members shall be one (1) year, and the initial term of six of the members shall be two (2) years. The term of the remaining five members shall be for three (3) years. The length of the initial term of these members shall be determined at the first meeting of the CJSB by lottery. Thereafter, each member, except those appointed to fill a vacancy, shall be appointed for a term of three (3) years from the date of the expiration of the term for which their predecessor was appointed. A presiding member shall be selected at the first meeting of the CJSB. Notwithstanding the foregoing, each member shall continue as such until his or her successor is appointed.
13. The CJSB shall meet a minimum of four (4) times per year to develop a strategic plan and to identify, develop and implement services aimed at achieving the CJSB's purpose, as defined by statute.

5. **Ownership of Facilities.** No facilities.


6. **Financing.** All grants will be approved by the Carbon County Board of County Commissioners prior to submission. In the event funding is obtained through the aforementioned grant, a proposal for expenditure of said funds shall be presented to the parties for approval. Upon receipt, funds shall be managed by the Carbon County Treasurer. Grant compliance shall be through the Carbon County Clerk or her designee. No party will be required to contribute any money to a project pursued through this agreement.


7. **Termination or Extension of Agreement.** A party may choose to leave this agreement upon a resolution of their governing body at any time. However, this agreement may

be terminated or extended upon majority vote and then adopted by each respective governing body to extend or terminate this agreement.
