MEMORIAL HOSPITAL BOARD

CSBG ACTION PLAN

Linda Fleming made a motion to establish the priority needs for Carbon County on the application process for the Community Service Block Grant. This motion was unanimously carried.

UNIVERSITY OF WYOMING AGREEMENTS

LIQUOR LICENSES

This motion was seconded by Linda Fleming and unanimously carried.
