SPECIAL PROSECUTOR

County Attorney Tom Campbell presented a resolution for the Commissioner's consideration.

A motion was made by Fleming, seconded by Graalman and unanimously carried to adopt the following:

RESOLUTION 1994 - 11

RESOLUTION APPOINTING SPECIAL PROSECUTOR

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Carbon County met in its regular meeting on September 5, 1994, at which time the County and Prosecuting Attorney declared to the Commissioners that a conflict had arisen, and that he had sought the assistance, pursuant to §9-1-603(d), W.S. 1977 of the Wyoming Attorney General's Office and that the appointment of members of that office as Special Prosecutors was now necessary to address the conflict; and,

WHEREAS, the law governing the appointment of attorneys other than the County Attorney allows for such an appointment when necessary, pursuant to \$18-3-303(c), W.S. 1977, (1994 Cum. Supp.), and;

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners at this meeting find that the existence of a conflict does in fact create such a necessity;

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED, that Bill Flynn and Georgia Tibbitts, Assistant Attorneys General of the Wyoming Attorney General's Office are by this Resolution appointed Special Prosecutors to act in the place of the Carbon County and Prosecuting Attorney in all respects as relates to the matter referred to them by the Carbon County Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that while no compensation for the services of the Assistant Attorneys General in this matter will be paid by the County, the actual and appropriate expenses attendant to a criminal prosecution will be paid by Carbon County upon presentation of those expenses for approval.

Bill Water and Beverly Derringer representing the Bureau of Land Management came to the Commissioners about public right-of-way on the Cherokee Road.

PUBLIC HEALTH/W.I.C.

Marci Newell R.N. representing Carbon County Public Health and W.I.C. programs, updated the Commissioner on the following problems she had identified in the county:

- 1. no obstetrical services at county hospital
- 2. Dr. Shine comes twice monthly for prenatal services
- 3. 96 miles for pregnant woman to travel for delivery
- 4. many families are low income
- 5. Wyoming State Penitentiary brings many women and families of inmates
- 6. high incidence of violence in families
- 7. high incidence of women with low self esteem
- 8. inner city poverty dynamics low income housing development
- 9. many families use emergency department as medical home
- 10. lack of any speciality medical services
- 11. high incidence of late prenatal care
- 12. high teen pregnancy rate

PLANNING

County Planner, Nina Adams gave her administrative report for the month of August.

A motion was made by Fleming, seconded by Graalman and unanimously carried to approve the following zone change:

Case File #94-09 - Zone Change - Dennis DaDant, 63 West Fifth Avenue, Berea, OH 44017. A Zone Change from RAM (Ranching, Agriculture and Mining) to two RD-5 (Residential Development - 5 acres) zoning designations on two subdivision parcels to allow for residential development. The parcels are legally described as Lots 22 and 25 in the Aspen Highlands #1 Subdivision, lying in the NE\SE\, NW\SE\; NE\SW\; SE\NW\, SW\NE\; and SE\NW\ of Section 10, Township 19 North, Range 81 West, Carbon County, Wyoming.

CARBON COUNTY MEMORIAL HOSPITAL BOARD

A motion was made by Graalman, seconded by Fleming and unanimously carried to appoint Curtis Rostad to a five year term on the Carbon County Memorial Hospital Board.

EXECUTIVE GROUP

- 4. Employee Handbooks (policy reference for County employees)
- 5. Management Policy Manuals policies and procedures reference manual for department heads and elected officials)
