DATA PROCESSING

Data Processing Clerk, Deb Weickum presented management reports and requested funds from the 1993-94 budget to purchase an external tape drive for the main frame computer at an estimated cost of \$4,744. The Commissioner's took the request under advisement.

TREASURER

Head Deputy for the Treasurer's office, Cindy Baldwin reported on tax collection and disbursements.

CORONER

Carbon County Coroner, Curt Rostad presented and discussed the proposed 1993-94 budget for the Coroner's office.

EXTENSION

The Commissioners signed a salary agreement between the University of Wyoming and Carbon County to employ a University 4-H Extension Educator from July 1, 1993 to June 30, 1994.

County 4-H Extension Agent, Tamra West presented estimates for repairs to the Ford vehicle used by the Extension Department. The Commissioners asked for two more estimates to be considered at the June 2nd meeting.

SHERIFF

Carbon County Sheriff, Chet Engstrom requested the V.O.C.A. employee be included on the Carbon County health insurance. The Commissioners will consider the request at 1993-94 budget meetings to be held at a later date.

CARBON COUNTY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORP.

Gene McMillen, representing Carbon County Economic Development, Corp. presented a resolution for consideration.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY CO } 11SSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF CARBON FOR A TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE GRANT FROM THE STATE OF WYOMING cmlunity DE-VELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM AND CERTIFYING THAT ALL PUBLIC PARTIC-IPATION REQUIREMENTS HAVE BEEN MET

WHEREAS, public notice of the public meeting to discuss the application for a Community Development Block Grant was published seven days prior to the hearing and informed citizens of the dollar amount available, the range of allowed activities and other pertinent information, as well as provided information concerning the time and location of the hearing; and

WHEREAS, citizen participation has been encouraged and provided for with particular emphasis on participation by persons of low and moderate income who are residents of slum and blight areas, and of areas in which CDBG funds are proposed to be used; and

WHEREAS, the Carbon County Economic Development Corporation, has requested that a CDBG - Technical Assistance Grant application in the amount of \$2,500.00 be submitted on their behalf for the benefit of Sand Lake Lodge, Inc.

WHEREAS, the jobs produced will be primarily for the low and moderate income people and,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners this day, hereby endorses the application for a CDBG - Technical Assistance Grant for the benefit of Sand Lake Lodge, Inc. and thereby approved the application for submittal to the Wyoming Economic Development and Stabilization Board for their consideration and anticipated approval.
